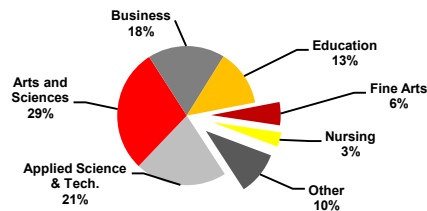

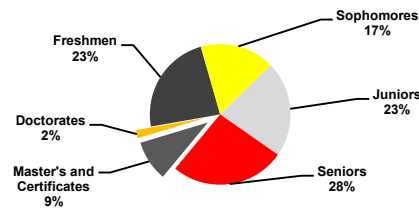

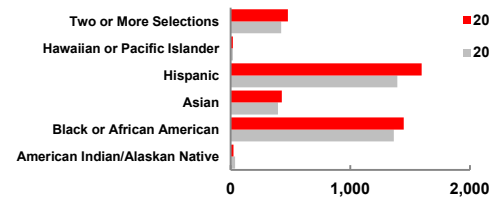

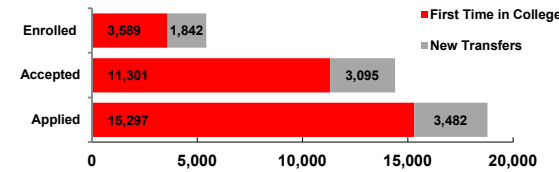

Retention - Percent of First Time in College Students Returning for the 2nd Fall

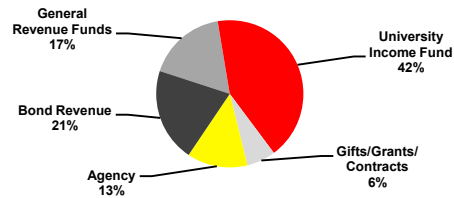

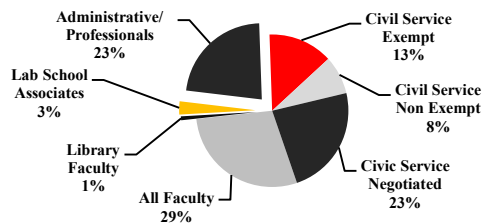

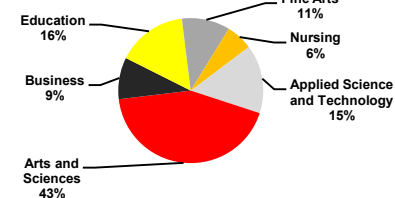
