

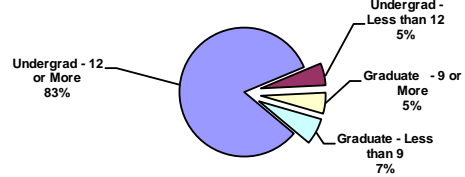

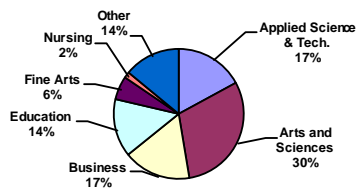

Enrollment by College Fall 2007

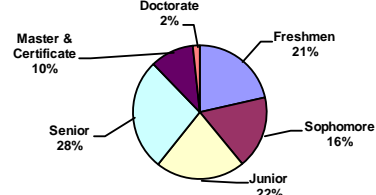

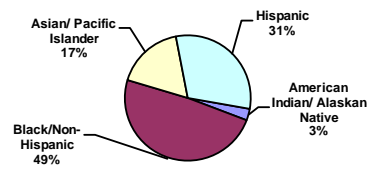

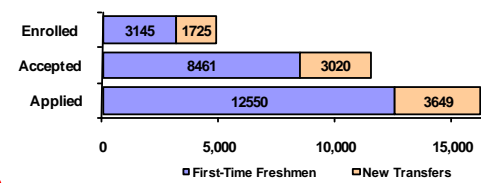

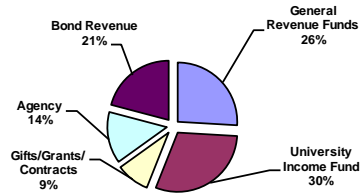

Operating Funds by Type (\$000)



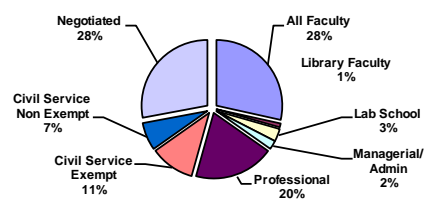

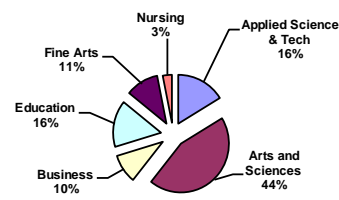
